ABOUT THE PROJECT

Silverstone was engaged to supply and install new HDPE piping associated with the relocation of South Jimblebar potable water bores.

SCOPE

- Supply and install 3km of DN200 PN20 PE100 Pipe Spec (F22)
- Survey and set out of PEAHR boundary.
- Grade and widen an existing access track x 5m, and recover Grub/Topsoil and stockpile.
- Install the new HDPE line into the existing Potable Water discharge line.
- ♦ Install new DN200 PN20 PE100 White Line up to new Bore Location HNPISJ0001.
- Install new DN200 PN20 PE100 White Line up to new Bore Location HNPISJ0002P.
- Hydrotesting and commissioning.
- NPI cleaning / sterilisation of internals.
- ◆ Traffic management control and implementation.

OUTCOME

Silverstone delivered critical potable water infrastructure on time and on budget. The teams commitment to safe work resulted in an incident free delivery.
